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INFORMATION ABOUT THIS GRANT

- This application and grant award are for MCCCCD students with Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) status that are affected by the increase in tuition rates for Arizona community colleges. - Applications must be complete to be considered for funding. Applicants who submit incomplete applications will be notified and allowed **2 weeks** to complete their applications.
- Complete applications will be considered for any available funding in the order they are received (or completed).
- The maximum amount awarded is the difference between the in-state and out-of-state tuition at the respective institution. It does not cover ***in-state tuition***, fees, books, or other related expenses. Grant checks are written directly to the institution.
- The application and all ***required*** documentation are kept confidential. FERPA protections apply to the educational institutions.
- You will be notified ***by email*** when your application is received and the status of your application.
